 As an interviewer I did research with adolescents in college on my school project, which aimed at assessing the factors that influence the use of contraceptives among adolescents.

 This was very hard, I was not very knowledgeable on how to engage adolescents

"Ethics" in research/ programming with adolescents

•Research ethics are moral principles that guide researchers to conduct and report research without deception or intention to harm the participants of the study or members of the society as a whole, whether knowingly or unknowingly.

 Researchers need to understand the stages of adolescence, their social background and know how to engage them.

They bring different needs that deserve to be met.

•They all deserve consent and assent, confidentiality, protection, respect, and transparency.

An example I have seen...

 Organization was interviewing adolescents about their lives at home,

-Adolescents explained their answers and expected that the organization would help them (with food, solve problems at home),

•They left and came with a different program not addressing the gaps they found during their research.

What should organizations do?

•Apart from considering all ethics in doing research with adolescents, the organizations should also be:

- Experts in working with adolescents
- Honest
- Protective
- Doing referrals
- Involving adolescents in the process
